DOLLAR MOUNTAIN prompted the pace then lacked the needed stretch response. P. BUCK dueled for the early lead near the inside then faded. JERSEY BROTHER bobbled at the start then was outrun. GOLDEN ONE was well placed close to the pace to the stretch then weakened.
