MARVIN ROAD rallied mildly for third. BLUE LIGHT SPECIAL was forwardly placed but lacked a rally. BORDER DISORDER chased the winner to the stretch racing removed from the rail then weakened. PACKER FAN failed to be a threat. POWERIFFIC lacked a rally. MERIDIAN HOUR was outrun. COMMERCIAL BOND tired. JO JO THE GREAT stumbled at the start then showed little.
