SCUFFLING SUMMER, prominent from the outset, could make up little ground in the stretch. BE GREAT failed to be a threat. YOUNG TROUBADOR prompted the early pace then weakened. WINNING ACTOR tired from his early effort. MOVIN' MAN showed little. RANDO COMANDO was outrun. REAL COLUMBIA BLUE tired. COUNTRY SHOWING broke slowly then was no threat.
