INDIAN PROMISE set the pace well off the rail under a snug hold, opened a long lead mid stretch and won under strong handling. MYPRINCESSABIGAIL was two wide, steadied in tight on the far turn, moved out and rallied. CALLIPYGIAN DREAM raced outside while just off the pace, finished well. HERE COMES NICE was wide and just off the pace, had no rally. DATRUTHOTHEMATTER steadied in tight on the far turn. MARY'S DANCER vied for command between foes and weakened. EMOTIONAL failed to menace. JIVE PARTNER broke slowly, was hustled up inside to race just off the pace and then tired. BLAZIN BETTY was very wide and failed to menace. HAWAIIAN HULA saved ground dueling and tired. TRUE ESSENCE dropped back steadily, took a bad step and fell in deep stretch.
