### Footnotes

LIGHTS OUT LEWIE moved up in the two path on the final turn, held a clear lead in the stretch and held on gamely. TAZALIYA outrun early inside, angled four wide rallying on the final turn but was outfinished. FEEL THE DANCE trailed for half a mile, rallied strongly in the stretch but was too late. DISCO SHAKER set a clear pace inside to the quarter pole then weakened. NOT VERY LADYLIKE was very wide throughout, bid at the far turn then faltered. CHI HORI raced far back then offered some late energy. WYATT'S WOMEN raced between rivals then gave way. LOVELY LUCILLE stalked the pace to the final turn then gave way. TAP RABBIT was always outrun. MYTHICAL EVENT raced close up inside then stopped abruptly.
