MISSTHEWIRE moved up leaving the backstretch to gain the lead then faded when unable to finish with the winner and held second. TEN QUEENS, never far back, responded well late to gain the show. ALWAYSINBLOOM prompted the pace then faded in the drive and bested the others. BEST ADVANTAGE tired from her early effort. DRED WING prompted the early pace and tired. DANCETHENIGHTRENEE showed little. MILLIGRAM tired.
