CLAM BAKE, prominent from the outset, collared the leader from the outside with a furlong remaining then drove clear. FEARLESS COWBOY vied for the lead from the outset and held on gamely to the end. SUMMITING matched strides outside rival and fought it out gamely to the end. THE MAD ARTIST was outrun to the stretch then responded well to close the gap. ITCH lacked the needed response in the final furlong. THEYCALLMEJOHNNY G rallied mildly. RITZY JONES broke alertly to be forwardly placed then lacked the needed rally. GRAND CAPTAIN failed to seriously threaten with a mild bid. METRO MAN showed speed from the outset then faded in the final furlong. SAARFACE raced close up along the inside early then weakened. MONTROSE AVENUE showed little.
