CUBICLE broke alertly to dispute the pace and held on well in the drive for second. GAL ON SKIS prompted the pace, lacked the needed rally and finished best of the others. FOSTRESS bobbled and was forced in at the start, raced close up to the stretch then faded. TRI THIS WAY failed to menace with a mild rally. NO ORDINARY STONE lacked a rally. BAYBERRY BLUE tired. SWEETIE G prompted the early pace and tired. GRADES OF HONOR showed little. TIME FOR MUSIC was always outrun.
