MOLTEN LAVA came out after the start causing crowding, joined for command outside, took over and drew out under mild handling. ACTIVE TRADER saved ground early, eased out in the stretch and gained place. FORWARD OBSERVER vied for command two wide and tired. HI CARD GAMBLER stumbled leaving gate and was jostled soon after, raced wide and faded. BUDDY'S SONG raced outside and faded. BLUE NOTION saved ground disputing the pace and tired. BOXER SHORTS, very wide, failed to menace. WAR NATIVE (IRE) was bothered after the start, had poor action and fell far back.
