TUFF HEROES saved ground rallying, started to move out entering the stretch but then was angled back to the rail, took the lead in deep stretch. CADENCE KING saved ground, took the lead leaving furlong grounds but was outfinished. WET 'N WILD CAT was well placed between foes, lacked a strong rally. UNCLE ELI raced outside and flattened out. LOOT A KRIS broke slowly and then clipped heels soon after, raced very wide and rallied. LAWDY ME set the pace off the rail and faltered. WHENHARRYMETSADIE was well placed outside, had no response. USUAL SUSPECT had his heels clipped after start and then was no factor. MY CENTURION vied for command between foes and tired. ATTICUS THE ROMAN showed little.
