LOCUST MOON rallied into the stretch then could gain little on the top two. SAYITWITHDIAMONDS, forwardly placed, lacked a rally. WHITE MTN. BREEZE prompted the pace and weakened in the drive. SECRET GOLD failed to threaten. KISSIN SUMMER showed little. HOOK SHOT broke alertly to vie for the early lead and tired. A DREAM TO FOLLOW tired. COUNTERMEASURES prompted the pace and faltered in the drive. DREAMING CREEK tired.
