Footnotes

IN FULL CONTENTION stalked the early pace then closed along the inside rail to challenge a furlong and edged clear late. DANDY WALTZ was sent through along the inside leaving the backstretch to gain the lead then was not good enough to withstand the winner. MINUTE, forwardly placed outside rivals, moved up menacingly on the far turn then faded in the drive. LONDON EYE was difficult to load, bobbled at the start then lacked the needed rally. RINGS ISLAND circled horses on the far turn then flattened out in the drive. RAY FEE KEES GOLD lacked a rally. CROSSWICKS broke alertly to set the early pace then tired. LION DRAWING saved ground to little avail. A SLOW GATE LOAD RESULTED IN A 5 MINUTE DELAY OF THE START.
