Footnotes

LADY LAURA G set a pressured pace toward mid track, drew clear on the turn then widened while kept alert. FIVE ALARM FLYER chased the pace toward mid track, proved no match for the winner but dueled for place. GRINAMIC was a step slow to start, settled into stride off the rail, began her drive on the turn, angled to the outside leaving the quarter pole then outfinished in the place duel. BENNINGTON showed no speed outside and finished evenly. TWO FER PLACE chased the early pace in mid track and weakened through the stretch. NOTIMETOQUIT was outrun outside. HANGWITHTHEHAVES pressured the pace from the inside and faded on the turn. BRASSY SHIRLEY bobbled at the start and never factored.
