BILL'S JERSEY was outrun early, rallied extremely wide rallying on the turn, lugged in late crowding rival then edged clear. ROYAL BRANDY was outrun early, rallied inside and was outfinished late. RED'S GOLD stalked the pace inside, led in the stretch and was taken up late. A claim of foul by the rider of RED'S GOLD against the winner was disallowed. CRAFTY KATARINA rallied six wide in the stretch then flattened out in the final furlong. SLEIGHT OF HAND set the pace off the inside to the stretch then faltered. BON CANDY was close up for half a mile then came up empty. GLOUCESTER STAGE within striking range early had no further response. CHUBBY BUBBY raced inside and stopped abruptly. THE SPARKSTER was far back throughout.
