Footnotes

SMOKIN NAILS broke sharp to vie for the lead racing off the inside rail, gave way in the final furlong then regained the lead in deep stretch. DERBY DAY RALLY, prominent from the outset, closed well in the final furlong. ROSEHANNA was outrun early then finished well to get up for third between rivals. RINGOFDIAMONDS was outrun to the stretch then finished well to just miss for third. RILED AGAIN chased the leaders from the outset and closed gradually in the final furlong. MISS DUMAINE vied two abreast, drew clear in the final furlong then broke down in her hindquarters in the final sixteenth mile. FOR FUN lacked a rally. CRAFTY MEME showed little.
