CAUSE TO SMILE closed to miss for the show between rivals. SUNDAY SHAPEUP failed to menace with a mild rally. PROCLAMA chased to the stretch then weakened. BELLA BLU showed little. MONEY CENTER BANK stumbled at the start. CAT GRACE tired from her early effort.
