COUNT THE GOLD pursued the pace inside, bid to the front in the stretch and just lasted. SIX CLICKS outrun early, saved ground to the stretch, angled out and rallied. DEACONS FARM outrun early outside, advanced six wide into the stretch and closed well. SELF DEALIN' MAN trailed to the stretch then found his best stride too late. UPBYAWINK made a menacing four wide bid on the turn, loomed boldly then faltered. KINGDA KA prompted the pace outside for half a mile then faded. SUNSHINE SATURDAY set a pressured pace, edged clear on the turn then stopped.
