PEARL STREET, reserved early, circled rivals far turn and began edging away late. PARTY GIFT broke alertly to dispute the pace and held on gamely. UNKNOWN SPIRIT rallied four-wide to challenge on the far turn and gave way grudgingly. LITLEDRUMMERGIRL, well-placed near the inside, loomed boldly through the stretch and faded late. SEATTLE SAILOR, inside early then between rivals to the stretch, weakened. JAVIAN prompted the early pace and weakened. TASTY DISH gained the lead early under restraint, vied to stretch and weakened. FIERY VICKY tired. TEJANO MELT steadily dropped back and was eased final furlong.
