Footnotes

STEAMROLLER BLUES chased the pace from the outside, advanced steadily in mid track on the turn, drew clear into the lane and widened slightly with steady encouragement. SUNSHINE BO chased the pace toward mid track, reached place midstretch then lasted in that position while weakening late. SUAVE LORD showed no early speed in mid track, started his drive on the turn, eased to the outside entering the lane and finished well. YARROWAY, alert to start, quickly took command outside, remained wide through the turn then leveled off in the lane. FELTON rated off the pace about the three path, started a bid nearing the quarter pole then weakened in the lane. RED EMBLEM gave chase from off the rail and weakened midstretch. TRAVELIN' HERO bobbled at the break and was outrun. POLISH KARMA was outrun widest. JOHNNY'S EXPRESS advanced toward contention inside, continued the chase through the turn then faded in the lane.
