I DARE BILLY waited back in mid track, advanced to the lead into the final turn, drew clear entering the stretch and held well with steady encouragement. CAPTAIN NEPAL rated back outside, bid into the final turn, remained close into the lane and dueled for place. BLIND CANYON rated off the pace toward mid track, bid between horses approaching the quarter pole then leveled off through the lane. QUEEN'S KISS, unhurried off the rail, bid approaching the final turn, came widest through the turn and finished evenly. KANDY KARD showed no speed inside then no rally. TINA'S GOAL gave chase toward the outside and tired into the lane. FAIR PROSPECT rated with the pace well off the rail, gave chase into the final turn and gave way at the quarter pole. HOOSICK FALLS hustled to the lead early in mid track, gave chase through the final turn and gave way at the quarter pole.
