Footnotes

ENDYMION stalked the pace off the rail, moved to the lead approaching the three eighths pole, raced clear on the turn and responded well to steady encouragement to last. I'MTRULYINTHEMOOD settled back outside, made a six wide bid into the turn and finished well at the withers of the winner. NOT FOR MONEY recovered stride quickly after stumbling from the gate, advanced toward contention outside, entered the stretch six wide but leveled off from the eighth pole. TRIPPED OVER chased the pace inside and leveled off through the lane. CASA D'ORO, off the pace in mid track, picked up the chase toward the turn and had nothing further in the lane. FERBER kept close to the early pace off the rail through the backstretch, was shuffled back at the inside flank of Tripped Over entering the turn and couldn't regain momentum. DEANOGUSKA came away sharply with the early lead to set the pace from the four path, gave chase through the turn then weakened in the stretch. FORT DENMARK rated close to the early pace outside then faded on the turn. FREE COUNTRY was kept in range about the three path on the backstretch then faded through the turn. STRAIT STRIPE, a step slow to start, was no factor.
