LITE UP THE NITE accelerated to the lead and rated when clear, came out a lane on the turn then widened to the wire with steady handling. VIVA CIELO steadied at the start, was roughed while the rider deliberated whether or not to enter narrow quarters near the half mile pole, started a drive five wide into the stretch and finished evenly for a clear place. JUDITHS EVENT chased the early pace inside then leveled off through the lane. SATAN'S POSSE chased the pace in mid track then had no stretch response. SMOKEY FELLA gave chase about the three path and weakened past the quarter pole. KALIK MON gave chase about the four path and weakened past the quarter pole. PHILLY BOUND gave chase outside and gave way toward the quarter pole.
