MISTER FIPS (IRE) quickly sprinted clear, widened his margin in the stretch and was never threatened. G'DAY MATE pursued the pacesetter outside then made a gradual gain in the final furlong. FUERTE chased the pace inside and continued well to the finish. VOODOO'S RUN saved ground to the stretch and lacked a rally. DRIVEN BY SAARLAND chased the loose pacesetter four wide and never menaced. IN A BREEZE raced between rivals and never menaced. THE MAN CAN STEP moved in the two path and gradually weakened. LITESCAMERACTION dropped far back racing wide and was always outrun. CIANO NIGHTS raced extremely wide and was never a factor. NIFTY MAMBO dropped back early and was never in contention. CUBS MOLINA was always outrun. HENRY R. gave way after a quarter mile. The race was delayed 28 minutes due to the breaking down of the horse ambulance while attempting to remove a stricken horse following the seventh race.
