KEEP DIGGIN rated back toward mid track, started a six wide drive into the turn then closed steadily outside to get the nod right at the wire. OPEN SPACE rated off the pace inside, made a three wide bid on the turn, dueled to the lead approaching the sixteenth pole but was outfinished the final stride. RAYOS Y TRUENOS rated with the pace two deep and between horses, dueled clear approaching the quarter pole, dug in for a hard drive through the lane and reluctantly ceded inside the sixteenth pole. BOLD EAGLE chased the pace toward mid track, entered the stretch five wide and remained a close factor to deep stretch before flattening stride. HOLY NUNZ rated back inside, bid into the turn, steadied at the heels of the waning Fastaslightning entering the stretch, came around that one to continue his drive but flattened the final sixteenth. OUT IN THE REIGN was slow into stride and never a factor. DEBEAR rated off the pace outside, made a six wide bid on the turn then weakened in the lane. SUNDAY WASH was never a factor. FASTASLIGHTNING rated with the pace inside, contested to a slim brief lead into the turn then gave way leaving the quarter pole. LOUANN'S BOOT had a brief lead for position three wide, gave chase on the turn then weakened into the stretch. BIG SILVERMAN steadied at the start and never factored.
