**Footnotes**

ARGENTINE DISPUTE stalked the pace from the inside, took over at the half mile pole, raced clear on the final turn, bore out under a left hand whip entering the stretch then lugged in under a right hand drive and just lasted. MISS SUGARMAGNOLIA showed no speed off the rail, circled the field while advancing through the final turn, entered the stretch extremely wide, steadily closed for place and was gaining well on the winner. HIDDEN JOY rated off the pace outside, closed to contention in the four path of the final turn then outfinished late for place. PANTSOFFTHEGROUND, off the pace about the three path, bid mildly through the final turn then leveled off in the stretch. BEACH KITTY settled off the pace toward the outside, bid mildly through the backstretch then faded on the final turn. HOPE TO WIN raced in range the opening half mile before beginning to fade. I'M WANTED held a short lead the opening half mile then readily faded on the final turn. ZIPPY JAN was through after a half. SWEET AS A KISS was pinched back at the break and lost contact early.
