WILDABOUT stalked the pace down the backside, saved ground around the turn, split horses and rallied to gain command under strong handling. TETON GOLD chased the early leader, continued on from between horses, was no match for the winner late but held the place. SUMMER OUTING well placed four wide, lacked a late response. CAPTIVA GOLD void of early speed, trailed down the backside angled out at the top of the stretch, finished well while wide. INDY LIMELIGHT set the pace, gave way. PATTON'S STAR failed to menace. JOJO JETTIN was no factor. MALOU'S MAGIC showed little. TAHITI PEARL was hustled along in the early going, stopped.
