Footnotes

DAN THE TIN MAN dueled outside of a foe, then drew off at the eighth pole while kept to task. TRIPLE CROSS was unrushed early, rallied four wide at the quarter pole, then couldn't get to the winner. SAINT ARBOR was clear early, dueled inside of the winner, then yielded late. WHERE'S DOMINIC bid five wide at the quarter pole, then hung in the drive. UPTOWN BOY stalked the pace four wide, bid at the three-eighths pole, then gave way late. DIVINE AMBITION stalked the pace three wide, then lacked a late bid. SILVER MORGAN was bumped at the start, stalked the pace inside, then faded late. MAC THE MAN was not a factor.
