CHIEF MENA outrun early, advanced outside entering the second turn., responded but could not reach the winner. BLUES BREEZE well placed inside, responded to pressure entering the stretch but was no match late. OUR MATILDA never far back early, had no late response. TRULY BROADWAY broke well from the inside to set the early pace and tired. GOOD CHEER was no factor. VANISHED was finished early.
