TIZ LATE was sent right to the front and set the pace, was well handled then drew off in upper stretch and was kept to task while leading throughout. SLAM DUNK was allowed to settled then raced two wide on the backstretch, rallied on the far turn and was gaining ground but was second best. BERNULLI was unhurried early then rallied four wide on the far turn and made a mild gain in the stretch. SUNSHINE KID was on the inside and saving ground throughout and far turn then raced evenly in the stretch. HARLAN STREET was three wide on the first turn and settled then raced four wide on the far turn making a mild bid then faltered in the stretch. IRON ID was allowed to settled then started a run and swung out to be five wide in upper stretch and was no threat. GROOVY KID raced four wide on the first turn and was outrun. CIRCUIT STAR chased the early pace while racing three wide, was used up and gave way on the far turn.
