ROCKIN' ROCKSTAR was unhurried early down the backside, rallied on the turn, split horses in the upper stretch, angled out in mid stretch and drew off under strong handling. DAZZLED SAINT broke well and set the pace with a clear lead, remained clear in mid stretch, could not hold off the winner late but was second best. HEROS REWARD hopped at the start and rushed up on the inside, contented throughout and finished willingly. EL GRAN SOL had good early position, was fanned out on the turn, then went evenly late. BARTLETTS well placed early, lost ground on the turn and could not gain. ESCROW KID slow early, was no threat. BIRDIE BEATS PAR wide early, did not menace. JR'S EXCHANGE chased for a half, gave way in the stretch.
