### Footnotes

FIRST RUN was allowed to settle early, rallied in the upper stretch four wide, closed determienly and prevailed late under firm handling. NOBLE CHARLOTTE was in hand early, rallied in the upper stretch and swung wide, finished well but could not reach the winner. CORLEONE well placed early, rallied on the second turn with a bid and gained a slight lead, was outfinished late. NURSE DOLCE had good early position on the inside, rallied in mid stretch but needed more late. SCREAMING REGAL slow early, swung wide in the upper stretch and had a late gain. TEN K CAT well placed early, rallied at the quarter pole four wide with a bid, flattened out in the stretch. MILITARY WIFE well placed, rallied on the second turn and drew close, gave way in the lane. MIRACLE BABY chased the early speed, dropped back on the second turn. CATALINA WAY set the early pace with a clear lead, folded up on the second turn. FAKE PERSONALITY raced mid pack early, then dropped back.
