### Footnotes

BRANDYS SECRET chased the pace off the rail, eased out midstretch and got up the final yards. INTO WISHES, shuffled back early, settled off the rail on the backstretch, came under a drive from the top of the stretch and finished well for place the final yards. SEPTEMBERHALFMOON was shuffled back toward the rail near the half mile pole, chased the leaders off the rail, entered the stretch about the four path, dueled close through the lane but leveled off the final yards. WISE AWAKE showed no early speed outside, made a six wide bid on the turn and had a strong finish. SET THE TREND was hustled to a slim lead for early position toward the inside, contested the advantage on the turn, dueled briefly clear in mid stretch then leveled off toward the wire. NEW ENGLANDER chased the pace off the rail, eased out in the upper stretch then leveled off toward the wire. ECHT was not a factor. MAC N MAYO chased the pace toward mid track, steadied briefly at the top of the lane and leveled off. LONGLEGGED ALI chased the pace from the inside then faded on the turn. TOSCA'S KISS was not a factor. SPEEDING TICKET cleared the field to her inside to press the pace inside, dueled a close factor to midstretch but gave way from there.
