Footnotes

GRAND OLD GAME, well back from the pace most of the backstretch, improved his position through the turn, eased three wide at the top of the stretch, rallied to the lead a sixteenth away and drew clear late. COUNT ON BUDDY rated a clear lead inside, was pressured toward the quarter pole, dueled with the advantage in the upper stretch, yielded to the winner at that point but dug in to retain place. PEACE CAT stalked the pace inside, gave chase from the three eighths pole, had aim at the top of the stretch and dueled a close factor to the sixteenth pole before yielding. ACE JORDAN kept close in the three path down the backstretch, bid into the turn, had aim four wide at the top of the stretch and leveled off through the lane. CATASTROS dropped back approaching the turn, angled widest at the five sixteenths pole and had no rally. BOOTLEG FLYER, off the pace outside, made a mild bid from the three eighths pole and weakened. NATIVE SOLEIL was not a factor. SMALL GIANT was through early.
