CERVEZA DE BARRIL broke a step slow and was allowed to settle, rallied in mid stretch four wide, closed fast and was along in time. COASTAL DREAMS stalked the pace and dueled three wide, held gamely in the stretch and just missed. MORNING GLASS dueled from the inside, held well in the stretch and was best of the rest. MY MARLIN well placed and saved ground, needed more late. EXPLOSIVE POWER pressed the pace and dueled while between horses, weakened in the lane. OFFICER MOO LA MOO never far back, lacked a late response and went evenly. LUCKY INDIAN was never a threat. UP SYNDROME was outrun.
