KENIKO stalked the early pace and was well placed, rallied in the upper stretch and split horses, drew clear late under confident handling. ZIPPIN FREE was unhurried early, rallied in the stretch four wide, finished well and was up for place. PERFECT ROMEO dueled on the lead the entire trip, weakened slightly late. T. V. TOMMY well placed three wide, lacked a late kick and went evenly. BERRA vied for lead, tired in the stretch. ROYAL CHAPEL never far back on the inside, tired in the stretch.
