TINTERN ABBEY allowed to settle early, had a mild bid while no threat. GOOD MOVER was hustled early to press the pace, tired in the stretch. TRUST IN ZACK had good position for a half, faltered in the stretch. POLISH MON was never a threat. CELTIC BEAR slow early, was always outrun. BELIEVE ITS SUNDAY showed little and was outrun.
