**Footnotes**

GENTLE ONE steadied leaving the gate, settled well back early, saved ground toward the turn, eased out from the quarter pole and closed steadily to get up the final stride. GRACELAND DIXIE rated the early pace two deep, widened control through the backstretch, was pressured from the three sixteenths pole then caught just under the wire. KISS ME ALREADY rated close inside, bid off the rail from the three eighths pole and finished evenly. PEANUT EXPRESS settled off the pace inside, bid leaving the three eighths pole, lost some ground leaving the turn then leveled off from midstretch. TOMISUE GOT EVEN rated back about the four path, bid through the turn but proved empty in the stretch. KIPABLE and BELLE OF THE CLASS were not factors. CHURCHILL'S PALACE, slow into stride, was not a factor. CRAFTY TIGRESS angled in to stalk the pace near the rail then weakened through the turn. TEAR IT UP was through early. STORMIN' AROUND steadied early and gave chase to the three eighths pole before fading on the turn.
