DIXIE'S ANGEL was away alertly, set the pace, drew clear through the stretch under strong handling. SELINA MOON had good early speed, chased the winner, was unable to gain but held the place. TRULY BROADWAY had good position, finished evenly. AFTER DARK was well placed four wide, lacked a late response. LEES MIST was void of early speed, passed tiring rivals. MERRYMONTMAY showed little. DEBERE slow early, failed to respond. STYLISH BELLE was through after a half. WINTER RIDGE raced in the middle of the pack, weakened. SWINGER DOLL was no factor. BLOOD DIAMONDS stumbled out of the gate, lost rider.
