SENSE TO COMPETE was bumped leaving the gate by GULF COAST BREEZE, took back off the pace into the first turn, dropped to the rail for the run down the backside, waited patiently behind a wall of four horses through the turn, angled out for the drive and drew off under strong confident handling in a professional debut. RAISING DAKOTA reserved early, moved to the leaders entering the turn, took command with a bold five wide seeping move through the turn, opened a clear lead but could not handle the winner when collared in the lane. DERBY EVE bumped with the winner when crowded at the start, moved to a stalking position through the first turn, moved to engage the leader two wide on the turn along with two others, dropped back slightly when between horses challenging for the lead and came again with a mild rally in the stretch for third. GULF COAST BREEZE broke inward bumping the eventual winner at the start, travelled three wide into the first turn, stalked the pace down the backstretch, moved four wide to challenge for the lead midway through the turn and weakened in the stretch. CARNIVAL KID set the pace to the turn, dug in along the rail when challenged on the turn and faded late. IGOTTHEMONEYHONEY trailed after a half and was never a threat.
