MYSTICAL MOUNT was unhurried early then rallied along the inside saving ground, slipped through the inside in mid stretch and was in a strong drive to prove best in the end. KNIGHT SHOT was inside on the run down the backstretch then shuffled back going into the turn, rallied two wide in the stretch and moved up to gain a slim lead in deep stretch but could not last in the final seventy yards. MASTER SPEAK dueled for the lead from the inside, drew off in upper stretch while in a strong drive then tired in deep stretch. BRAULIO was two wide on the turn then made a mild rally in the stretch and was no threat. WAR FIGHTER raced three wide on the turn while in the second flight then failed to respond when asked in the stretch drive. PETCH rallied three wide on the turn then faltered in the stretch drive. KING ANDREW raced five wide on the turn and faltered in the stretch. QUICK SHOOTER dueled for the lead while two wide, was used up and stopped. FIVE STAR ERA raced four wide on the turn and was no threat. DON'T DO THAT BABY raced six wide on the turn and was no factor.
