MAID FOR JOE sprinted away to an open lead, well rated through turn, drifted out turning for home and prevailed as much the best while being kept to task. FOREST PATH moved to a stalking position, challenged on the turn, could not gain on the leader but held the others safe. MOONSHOT MONKEY reserved off the pace closed willingly through the stretch. XPRESSLY MINE made a mild rally in the lane. AREDHEL raced two wide in the turn just off the leaders and lacked any late response. PRETTIFUL raced between horses down the backside, was jostled heading to the turn, backed out of tight quarters and weakened.
