SHAKE IT OFF stalked the early pace from the outside, steadily advanced entering the turn, responded when sat down for the drive and wore down rivals inside the furlong grounds. ROCKER CHAD chased the early pace from the inside, inched closer entering the turn, altered outside for the drive, gained a short advantage between calls but could not last. SEEKING AFFAIRS forced the early pace from the outside, remained forward entering the drive but could not match strides. STEVEN'S AFLEET broke well from the outside to gain the early advantage, remained clear entering the stretch but could not keep pace. FLATTER TIME went evenly. AFRIKON was no factor. SOAR SLEW SOAR was no threat. AMELIAISLANDMISSLE had a steady fade.
