ELECTION DAY was allowed to settle into stride then was hustled along while two wide on the backstretch to get good position going into the turn, rallied on the turn and was in a strong drive to split rivals in late stretch to prove best in the end. KAYLE PRINCESS was chasing the early pace then rallied four wide on the turn, made a strong bid to late stretch but hung in the end. CHASING DAYLIGHT dueled for the early lead while two wide under a fast pace, was used up and weakened in late stretch. CHAI SUSIE was hustled along the inside on the backstretch then made a mild rally two wide but was no menace in late stretch. CLIQUE was unhurried early, started a mild rally in the stretch on the inside but was no threat. KATY'S CUPCAKE broke sharply then raced four wide on the turn while failing to menace in the stretch. ZURI'S GIRL was unhurried early then moved out to four wide in the stretch and was no threat. DAY TRIPPI dueled for the early lead from the inside while setting fast fractions, was hard used and stopped in the stretch.
