Footnotes

OLYMPIST dropped well back from early contention to save ground, bid angling outward from the three eighths pole, entered the stretch six wide, closed to the front a furlong away and edged away from the sixteenth pole. EON was boxed at the rail from the half mile pole to the three sixteenths pole, bid near the rail from the eighth pole and finished best for place. BOOM DE YA DA stalked the early pace about the three path, eased five wide into the stretch then leveled off the final furlong. MEGA WONDER rated a slim lead inside, maintained the advantage to contest the turn, lost ground entering the stretch and weakened from the eighth pole. TERREMOTICO showed no speed inside, closed the margin gap though lacked room in the upper stretch and leveled off the final furlong. J'S SUNNY LIDO settled back off the rail, bid from the three eighths pole, was blocked in the upper stretch, angled to the outside but lost all chance from that point. WANA PLAY, with the pace two deep, contested the turn, was carried out entering the stretch and weakened.
