ANOTHER GULCH pressed the pace,gained a slight edge mid stretch,dueled to the wire and just missed. CORNELL was wide on the first turn,settled in the middle of the pack,closed willingly. CAJUN DUST was unhurried early,passed tiring rivals. BOOMERANG STAR had good position five wide,offered no rally. WHYWHYDANCER showed little while racing on the rail. OREE slow early,was outrun while wide. CHERCHUESE D'OR bore out on the first turn,was through after a half while wide.
