LAIRD'S QUEST stalked the pace three wide, bid six wide at the three-sixteenths and drew off late under a steady drive. CONSORT stalked the pace four wide, bid at the quarter pole, then couldn't match strides late. FOREMAN dueled outside of a foe, then gave way late. ETHICS REFORM stalked the pace four wide, bid at the three-sixteenths pole, then was steadied at the eighth pole. TWO POINT FAVORITE and IMPERIAL ORDER had mild late bids outside but faltered in the drive. BLITZENSDISCOGETEM vied inside before giving way in the drive. BROWN FEATHER stalked the pace five wide, bid at the quarter pole, then faltered in the drive.
