J T KINGFISHER stalked the pace inside, bid between rivals at the half-mile marker, then drew off in the stretch while kept to task. BENSON stalked the pace three wide, lacked a bid but was the best of the rest. SIR JOCK stalked the pace inside but lacked a bid. I'M A WAHOO was clear early but couldn't last. SO BUSTED was off awkwardly and was steadied out just out of the gate, bid four wide at the half-mile pole, then faltered in the drive. BISHOP CASEY raced five wide, bid at the half-mile pole, then faltered in the stretch.
