**Footnotes**

COME UNDONE attended the pace along the rail, lacked running room at the half, waited for an opening at the top of the stretch to bid between rivals and get the lead, holding safe under a mild drive. CHABICHOU saved ground early, angled out four wide at the top of the stretch, bid but couldn't get past the winner. BUCKY led inside but was outfinished. MT. FUGI was off awkwardly, stalked the pace three wide but lacked the needed bid. BACKTRACKEN duelled outside of the leader, stuck a head in front on the turn but gave way in the drive.
