HELLO FROM HEAVEN had good speed away from the gate to gain command, was well rated on the lead, dug in through the stretch and prevailed under a strong drive. RED PLAYS ROUGH had good position, was hustled along on the far turn, chased the winner to the wire and held the place. LAIRD'S QUEST unhurried early to trail while in hand, saved ground entering the stretch, angled out for the drive and finished well to be gaining on the top two. OCHO CABALLOS was well placed while saving ground, lacked a late response along the rail. LIL SKELETOL was no threat when racing four wide throughout.
