Footnotes

FLYINGPALM stalked down the backside racing four wide, chased WESTERN KNIGHT under an all out drive from upper stretch, was slowly gaining in deep stretch, came to the wire racing between rivals, prevailed in last jump under a stiff drive. CUT AND SHOOT was bumped and taken up slightly at the break, settled under a rating, launched rally five wide entering the stretch, hit best stride late, surged at the wire to narrowly miss. WESTERN NIGHT made a slight bobble at the break, quickly recovered and was sent up to take the lead, set a pressured pace throughout, maintained a slight edge inside the sixteenth pole, was out gamed in last strides, hard effort. NO PASSING ZONE was outrun to the quarter pole, came six wide into the lane, hit stride mid stretch, was finishing fast at the wire, too late. THE FINAGLER settled early, rushed bid mid turn, loom behind wall of duelers at the quarter pole, had the rail entering the stretch, failed to sustain bid, flattened out. LITE LEGACY veered in to bump CUT AND SHOOT at the start, raced evenly at mid track throughout, failed to menace. BENGAL LORE was brushed lightly leaving the gate, hustled to stalk, raced between rivals on the bend, gave way turning for home, used up.
